









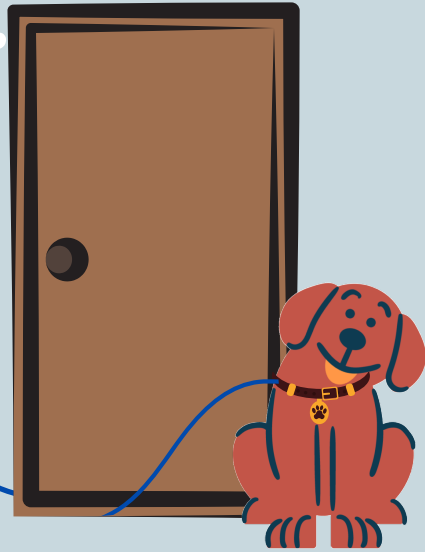

# Maintenance

## Outdoor Dog Cables
