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


## Hello Members!

# **Exploring the Details of Groupcast**

A couple years ago, Highlands switched to a new mass messaging system called Groupcast. This is what we use to send important notifications to every household - like snow plow alerts, property information, important due date's.

- 1) You can have up to 4 phone numbers and 2 emails for one address.
- 2) You can include occupants as any of the phone numbers or emails.
- 3) You can decide if you want any combination of phone, email, or text notifications
- 4) You can choose the language you want to receive messages in written form.

#### **Avoid Dog Feces Fines!**
