In situations which can lead to legal eviction of Members, the Board of Directors will examine alternatives to the eviction. However, the Board of Directors will not hesitate to evict a Member who continually violates Cooperative policies or regulations. Some frequent reasons for evictions include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Delinquent payments of carrying charges.
- 2. Pet Policy violations.
- 3. Disturbances to neighbors.
- 4. Destruction of Cooperative property.
- 5. Violence or threats of violence to other Cooperative Members or their guests, employees, or Board Members.
- 6. Drug related or other illegal activities.
