CURTAINS/WINDOW TREATMENTS

Curtains/window treatments are defined as material designed for the sole use of covering window openings.

Installation and removal of curtains, drapes, blinds, or other window treatments is the Member's responsibility. When the hardware is mounted on the wall, it is recommended you use a stud finder to locate the studs, which are approximately 16 inches apart. Use wood screws that are at least 1-1/4 inches long. If you cannot locate the studs, use toggle bolts or similar hardware designed for this purpose. Any damage to drywall will be the responsibility of the Member to repair.

When a window treatment is attached to a door, no holes, screws or any other means of connecting to the doors is allowed that requires a hole to be put in the door. See Door Policy for details.
