When you choose to live in multi-family housing you need to be respectful of your neighbors when residing closely together. When a large number of people live closely together as they do in the Cooperative, problems and noises are bound to arise.

If you are experiencing problems with your neighbors, you are urged to talk politely and tactfully with said individual regarding the nature of the problem and explore ways to resolve the issue. This is usually an effective way to quickly defuse and resolve neighborly disputes.

If you are asking your neighbor to compromise a little, you must be willing to do the same.

If talking with your neighbor(s) does not solve the problem, you are urged to outline the conflict and any conversations with your neighbor in writing via letter or email. Unsigned or verbal complaints will not be investigated.

Management does its best to keep all signed complaints confidential. If legal action and a court case are required to resolve the issue, you may be required to appear as a witness.
