Play areas and equipment are located throughout the Cooperative.

Members are urged to report any broken, defective, or vandalized equipment to the Office. Report immediately any vandalism in progress to the Office during regular business hours, and to the police after Office hours.

The parking lots are not to be utilized as a play area.

## **POOLS**

Portable pools must be kept in the back of the townhouse. Pools may not be used in the front of the townhouse.

The following guidelines must be followed:

- 1) The pool cannot be any larger than 78 inches in diameter and 14 inches in depth.
- 2) Water cannot be left in the pool overnight.
- 3) The location of the pool should be changed each day to prevent damage to the grass.
- 4) The pool must be removed from the lawn area daily.

Pools cannot be stored outside between the months of September and May.

## JUMPING, ACROBATIC, GYMNASTIC EQUIPMENT

No jumping, acrobatic, or gymnastic type equipment such as balance beams, trampolines, parallel bars etc. will be allowed to be used or stored outside of the Member's townhouses.

## **SWING SETS**

Member owned swing sets are not allowed on Cooperative property.

## **SANDBOXES**

Portable covered sandboxes are allowed but must be placed in a maintenance strip or on a deck or patio. If any other type of sandbox is desired, an Alteration/Installation Permit must be obtained from the Office and approved by the Board of Directors.
