

TREE/SHRUB

An Installation/Alteration Permit must be submitted to the Cooperative before any removal or planting of trees and/or shrubs.

The Board of Directors or their designee must approve the Installation/Alteration Permit.

The location of the tree and/or shrub must be approved by the Board of Directors or their designee.

Trees cannot be planted within 15 feet of any building or sidewalk. Shrubs may be planted near the building if it is a foundation type shrub.

The Member has the responsibility of calling Miss Digg.

If the Member submits the cost of the tree to the Board of Directors, the Board may approve paying 1/2 of the cost (not to exceed \$125.00).

Once the tree and/or shrub is planted, it becomes the property of the Cooperative.

Any damage to the Cooperative's property or other's property, caused during the installation process, is the Member's responsibility.

Removal of any trees and/or shrubs must be approved by the Board of Directors. If a living tree and/or shrub is removed, the Member will be charged for replacement of the tree and/or shrub upon leaving the Cooperative.
